ART AND CULTURAL EXCHANGE PROGRAM



Mysmallhelp received a visit from a Malaysian girl, **Hwei Ling** who is currently studying in USA. Hwei Ling arrived in Kathmandu on 11th May 2008 to share her culture and teach art.

Hwei Ling spent 6 weeks in Nepal and took classes in 3 different schools. **Vidya Sadan School, Lotus Boarding School and Marybert School**



HEALTH AND HYGIENE PROGRAM



Two medical students **Dana Khorati** and **Rhianon Marie Evans** from **Cambridge University** spent time volunteering for Mysmallhelp in August. Dana and Rhianon conducted a Health and Hygiene programme at the National Campus with about 50 students from 4 different schools on 29th June 2008

A small survey was taken from the students and the program was very educational and helpful for all students

A medical kit was provided to all 4 schools



Mysmallhelp was approached by the international childcare trust in London in September. Philippa Loates of the international childcare trust visited the Mysmallhelp, Nepal team in September whilst looking for a potential partner for funding and working on a 5 year project in Nepal.

Mysmallhelp was one of various charities which were visited. On her return to England Philippa informed Mysmallhelp, UK that Mysmallhelp, Nepal had been recommended to the ICT board of trustees. Philippa recommended the Mysmallhelp, Nepal team as she felt that they were very kind, honest, welcoming and trustworthy.

Philippa would specifically like to work with Mysmallhelp, Nepal as she felt that the team was genuine people that really want to help the poor and need. Mysmallhelp, Nepal were requested to complete the second round application forms for funding and partnership before 19th December



Eilidh Canney from Scotland raised **£270** and provided **44 children** with **school uniforms** at the **Bhattedanda School**

Eilidh helped msh to survey Bhattedanda village for a potential partnership project with the International Childcare Trust

The Bhattedanda school is located in Bhattedanda area of Lalitpur District which is 26km South of Kathmandu.

- The population is 4,500 people.
- There are 400 houses
- 70% of the population are illiterate
- The main occupation is agriculture and cattle farming

Sport equipments was bought for Marybert School with remaining Mysmallhelp funds.
